

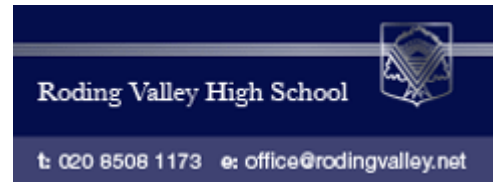

Roding Valley High School, Alderton Hill. As part of the development of the 6th form, there will be a Public Consultation on the school's proposed large new building on the corner of Alderton Hill and Brook Road, next Wednesday (July 13th). 3 – 6pm in the school hall. All welcome.



Oaklands School have appealed against the District Council's rejection of their recent planning application. The school applied for 30 more pupil places and a car-park and drop-off area on land off Warren Hill. The appeal is to be decided on the basis of Written Representations and a site visit by an Inspector. Traffic & parking by staff and parents causes considerable problems for nearby residents.
