The hospital has rejected the option of re-building on the existing site in favour of building a new hospital on the borders of Harlow.

Wo Fat, 270-272 High Road. On March 19th a District Council Licensing sub-committee revoked Wo Fat's alcohol licence – the revocation will take effect unless there is an appeal within 21 days. The police asked for the revocation under the Licensing Act 2003 and the licensing objective of preventing Crime and Disorder, because illegal immigrants had been employed there. Employing illegal immigrants is a serious crime and this is stressed in more recent updates to the 2003 Act.

Local Policing improvement.

A planned increase in staffing by Essex Police will result in Loughton acquiring two Town Centre Teams by Summer 2019. They will be managed by a sergeant as part of the wider Community Policing Teams (CPTs), building on local knowledge, and will be focussing on providing a visible policing presence, increasing local community engagement, working closely with local partners, businesses and retailers and reducing crime and antisocial behaviour.
