URGENT MESSAGE

The Loughton Broadway (Debden) area is experiencing some unprecedented proposals for change.

1. The Epping Forest District Council's new Local Plan is proposing 7 potential opportunity areas in our ward for housing, retail and commercial development (pages 106-114 of the EFDC 'Planning Our Future' consultation document). You only have until **15th October** to take part, so don't delay have your say. 2. Epping Forest District Council has produced a draft Broadway Regeneration Action Plan outlining their proposals to develop the Broadway area. This was presented at the EFDC North Weald Airfield and Asset Management Cabinet Committee on **5th September 2012**.
